With Ilene Frank (Principle Investigator) and Drew Smith. A class, "Teaching Information Literacy" was designed and taught in Spring Semester of 2001 and 2002. Recruited five TA's for 2001 and four TA's for 2002. In 2001, five took the course and in Fall, 2001 taught 300 freshmen enrolled in the USF Learning Communities, as well as participated in the library instruction program. In 2002, the four took the course and participated in the library instruction program. Grant extended from July 1 through December 31, 2002.
